## GET YOUR PUPILS INVOLVED:

*Why not hold a dress down day with a twist?*



Ask pupils to contribute £2 each to African Revival to take part in a dress down day with a difference.

## Activities for your dress down day:



### Early Years and Primary Age Children

- Make and decorate **African Animal Masks** using our great templates
- Print out, colour-in and identify our **fact sheet of African animals**.
- Make **African footballs** - full instructions provided!
- **For younger children** – Watch the DVD supplied by African Revival. Encourage the children to talk about what they saw in the film and which parts of the film were happy or sad. Ask them to talk about the difference between the lives of children in Africa and their own lives in the UK.
- **For older children** - watch the DVD supplied by African Revival. Write a short story imagining that you are a child living in Zambia. Use the attached fact sheet to help the children understand key facts about school life in Zambia. Ask the children to explore how this compares to living in the UK.



# Go one step further...

## Hold an African Theme Day!

Ask children to get sponsored by parents and friends and host your very own "African Day".

Children are sponsored to complete a set of five tasks relating to Africa. On our website you can download a sponsorship form and a fantastic certificate of thanks for each child taking part. You could use your own ideas or perhaps those suggested below:

1. Hold a **sponsored game of football** using African footballs
2. Make an **African Mask** using our great mask templates
3. Hold an **African quiz** using our prepared questions
4. Learn an **African song** using the links on our website
5. Paint some **African animal picture** using our handy templates
6. Invite **African Drummers** into the school to hold a drumming workshop with the children

**Remember, as well as receiving a new themed DVD from us each term you can also download lesson plans from our website, so not only will your pupils be fundraising – they will be learning about life in another country.**
